BELONGING TO THE HOLY FAMILY COMMUNITY

Families that choose to join the Holy Family community are committing to the philosophy of shared responsibility in the education of their child. It is a partnership between the parents and the school that supports the development of the whole child. What makes our parish school so special is that it is a community in the truest sense of the word - a place where our young people can gather to learn and experience our common faith and tradition as believers in Jesus Christ. Research has shown that children whose parents are involved in their child's education do better in the academic environment. In understanding this philosophy, we have instituted several programs and activities to encourage our parental involvement. Below is a list of these activities and a brief description of the expectation for participation.

Tuition

As a private Catholic educational institution, our operating budget is funded solely by tuition payments made by parents and fundraising activities throughout the year. Tuition for the school year is based on teacher and staff salaries, and other educational costs. Tuition may be paid monthly or yearly. A tuition schedule is handed out yearly, along with a tuition agreement. In order to receive the discounted tuition rate a Tuition Discount Request Form must be on file. This form needs to be *completed each school year*. To qualify, a family must be enrolled at Holy Family School, volunteer for school activities, be current with Scrip commitment and volunteer hours, be a registered member of Holy Family Parish, attend Mass regularly at Holy Family Parish, contribute in a consistent manner to support the parish using Parish Pay, and volunteer for parish ministries.

Service Hours

Each family has an obligation to complete 40 hours of service each year. Single parent families and preschool are required to fulfill 20 hours. The purpose of this program is for all school parents to participate as volunteers in the activities of the school and/or parish. Activities include, but are not limited to, teacher aide, board member, field trip driver, working at festival, etc. A list of opportunities is sent home at the beginning of the school year, and may be found on our web site. In order to volunteer at Holy Family School, cleared fingerprint reports must be on file in the school office.

Scrip Commitment

Each family is expected to purchase 4,000.00 of Scrip per school year to help offset operating budget expenses. This amount must be reached by the end of April 2013. Our list of Scrip participants is extensive to help all families meet this commitment.

PTG Fundraising Participation

Our Parent-Teacher Group (PTG) sponsors several major fundraising events each year. These fundraisers currently are: a Fashion Show in the fall and Jog-A-Thon in the spring. The school also has an Annual Golf Tournament and Enchanted Evening Dinner/Dance Auction. All of the money raised goes to support the operating budget of the school, or specific projects that are not covered by the school budget. All families are required to participate in and support our fundraising events in some capacity.

School Development

Our "Gifting of Faith" appeal will be used to fund our long-range plan which includes technology upgrades and other needed improvements. Last year we were able to raise over \$50,000 for the school. This is a tax-deductible way to help support the school. We ask our families to support this appeal based on their financial capabilities.

Faculty: All teachers are college graduates with full teaching credentials, many have advanced degrees.

Core Program: Religion, Mathematics, Language Arts (Reading, Phonics, English, Spelling, Handwriting), Natural Sciences and Social Sciences. Algebra (offered to qualified 7th and 8th grade students).

Weekly: Music, Physical Education, Library, Computer, Art and Spanish

Religious Formation and Activities: The school day starts with a school wide prayer. There are also monthly liturgies, prayer services, sacramental preparation, seasonal spiritual activities and retreat opportunities

Extra Curricular Activities: Academic Chess Club, Community Outreach, Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, Student Council, Lego Robotics, Girls on the Run and California Junior Scholarship Federation.

Sports: Basketball, Volleyball, Track, Softball (Girls), and Flag Football (Boys) for students in 5th-8th grades.

Student Services: Day Care – 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Learning Assistance Program for students in K-3rd grades and Occupational Therapist for students in Preschool thru 4th grades.

Parent Involvement: Parents are required to volunteer 40 hours per year for a two-parent family, 20 hours for a single parent and preschool. A \$4,000.00 yearly family purchase of Scrip (gift cards) and support of our fundraisers is also required.

Current Registration: Registration fees, after acceptance, are \$400.00 per child (non-refundable).

* **TUITION FOR 2012/2013 WILL BE SET BY END OF APRIL 2012**

To receive the tuition discount rate, a family must fill out a Tuition Discount Request Form and meet the following requirements:

1. **Must be enrolled in Holy Family School to be eligible for discounted rate**
2. **Must be registered in Holy Family Parish to be eligible for discounted rate**
3. Must have a completed Tuition Discount Request Form approved by the parish and school and meet all of the requirements
4. Volunteer for parish ministries and school activities
5. Fulfill Scrip and parent volunteer hours requirements for the school
6. Attend Mass regularly at Holy Family Parish.
7. Contribute in a consistent manner to support the parish using Parish Pay

HOLY FAMILY SCHOOL APPLICATION INFORMATION AND ADMISSION POLICY

All students interested in applying to Holy Family School must meet the following age criteria:

- Preschool – age 3 by September 1, 2012
- Kindergarten - age 5 by September 1, 2012
- First Grade - age 6 by September 1, 2012

*Exceptions may be considered and must be based on specific criteria of readiness and performance. The decision will be made only after consultation with the parents, teacher, and Principal.

When selecting students for admission to Holy Family School, preference is given in the following order:

- Siblings of current Holy Family School students
- Registered, active Holy Family Parishioners
- Registered, active Catholics of another parish
- Catholics who are either not registered, non-participating, or non-supporting members of a Catholic parish
- Non-Catholics

Grade Readiness Testing

Holy Family School tests every applicant for grade readiness. Grade Readiness testing will be held on Wednesday, February 8, 2012 between 1:30 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. for our Kindergarten applicants and on Wednesday, March 7, 2012 for our 1st-7th grade applicants. The test consists of age-appropriate evaluation for the younger grades and age-appropriate curriculum review for the upper grades. You must have a completed application on file by February 3, 2012 (priority status) for Kindergarten, and by February 17, 2012 for 1st-7th grade to attend testing.

Completed Application Consists of the Following:

1. Application Fee - \$60.00 (Non-refundable)
2. Copy of County Birth Certificate (not a hospital copy)
3. Copy of Baptismal Certificate (if baptized)
4. Preschool evaluation or progress report (if applicable)
5. Copies of the previous two years Report Cards (1st-7th grade)
6. Copies of all Standardized Test Scores (1st-7th grade)
7. Current Teacher Recommendation Form (all grades)
8. Copies of Immunization Records (all grades)
1. Completed Application turned in no later than February 3, 2012 (Kindergarten, priority) and February 17, 2012 (1st-7th grade)

Return your application to Sheryl Citta, Admissions Director. Testing times will not be scheduled until your application is complete.

Acceptance Procedure:

Acceptance information is not available by phone. All letters will be sent by March 2, 2012 for Kindergarten (priority) and March 29, 2012 for grades 1st-7th. All registration forms and a non-refundable registration fee of \$400.00 are due by March 11, 2012 for Kindergarten and April 9, 2012 for grades 1st-7th.
